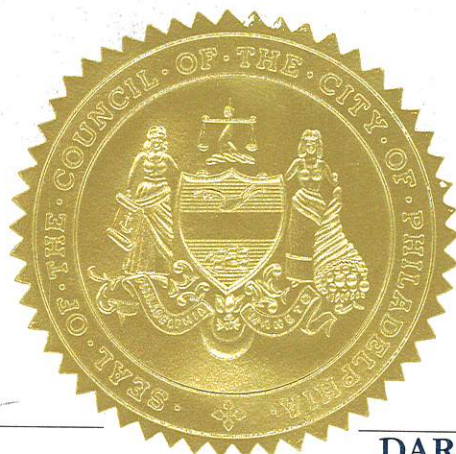
Whereas, The Philadelphia Chapter of WTS proudly announced PhilaPort as the recipient of its 2017 Diversity Award; and


Whereas, PhilaPort manages, maintains, markets, and promotes the port facilities along Pennsylvania's Delaware River. PhilaPort is committed to strategic planning throughout the port district. In 2016, PhilaPort launched an effort to expand its Diversity and Outreach Program. In doing so, intensified its commitment to Historically Underutilized Business (HUB) enterprises. Their goal is to expose more consultants doing business at the port while simultaneously exposing those primes to the vast network of subcontractors at the port.

Whereas, PhilaPort's 2017 Diversity and Inclusion Program is the first in the city to include the LGBT category for business. This effort raises the bar for the entire City of Philadelphia. PhilaPort is a member of the National Gay and Lesbian Chamber of Commerce (NGLCC). This effort raises the bar for the entire City of Philadelphia category of businesses not commonly included in such programs; and

Whereas, PhilaPort's 2017 Diversity and Inclusion Program requires that 20% of the work from all contracts be subcontracted to certified minority, women, veteran or LGBT-owned businesses. PhilaPort will subject all projects, that informally, to the new Diversity and Inclusion Policy.
