Re: ADDENDUM NO. 2

23-026.1 - RFP for Design Build of Temperature Controlled Warehouse

This Addendum No. 2 is issued to:

- 1. Clarify that prospective proposers (as well as their team members, contractors, subcontractors, consultants or subconsultants) that played any role in the creation, preparation, modification of the design specifications for this procurement may be precluded from competing in this procurement pursuant to 23 C.F.R. § 636.116.
- 2. Respond to the following question received:
  - Q1: If the DBC and the DBC's retained professional have common ownership individuals and/or entities, would the ownership and relationship between DBC and the DBC's retained professional be seen as a conflict of interest and potentially disqualify our bid?
  - A1: A Design Build Contractor with common ownership or other affiliation to the Design Build Contractor's Retained Professional does not, by itself, create an organization conflict of interest ("OCI") for this project, so long as: (1) the common ownership or affiliation does not create an actual or potential OCI as described in the Conflict of Interest Certification on page 2 of RFP Appendix A and/or in all other applicable authority relating to OCIs, including but not limited to 23 C.F.R. § 636.116, 48 C.F.R. §§ 9.505-1 through 9.505-4; and (2) the DBC and its commonly-owned or otherwise affiliated Retained Professional can each make the certification required by the Conflict of Interest Certification on page 2 of RFP Appendix A.

All other terms and conditions remain unchanged.
