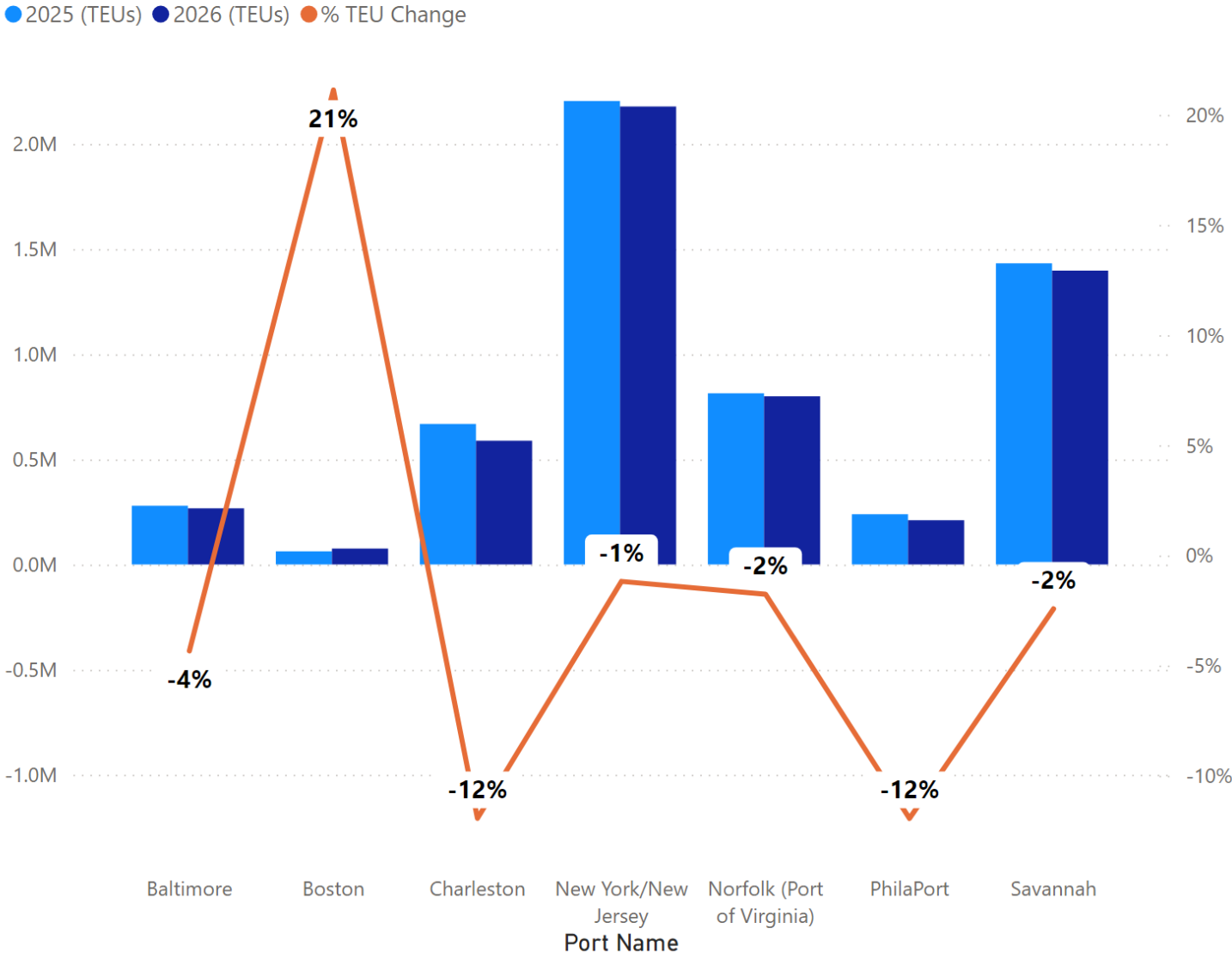

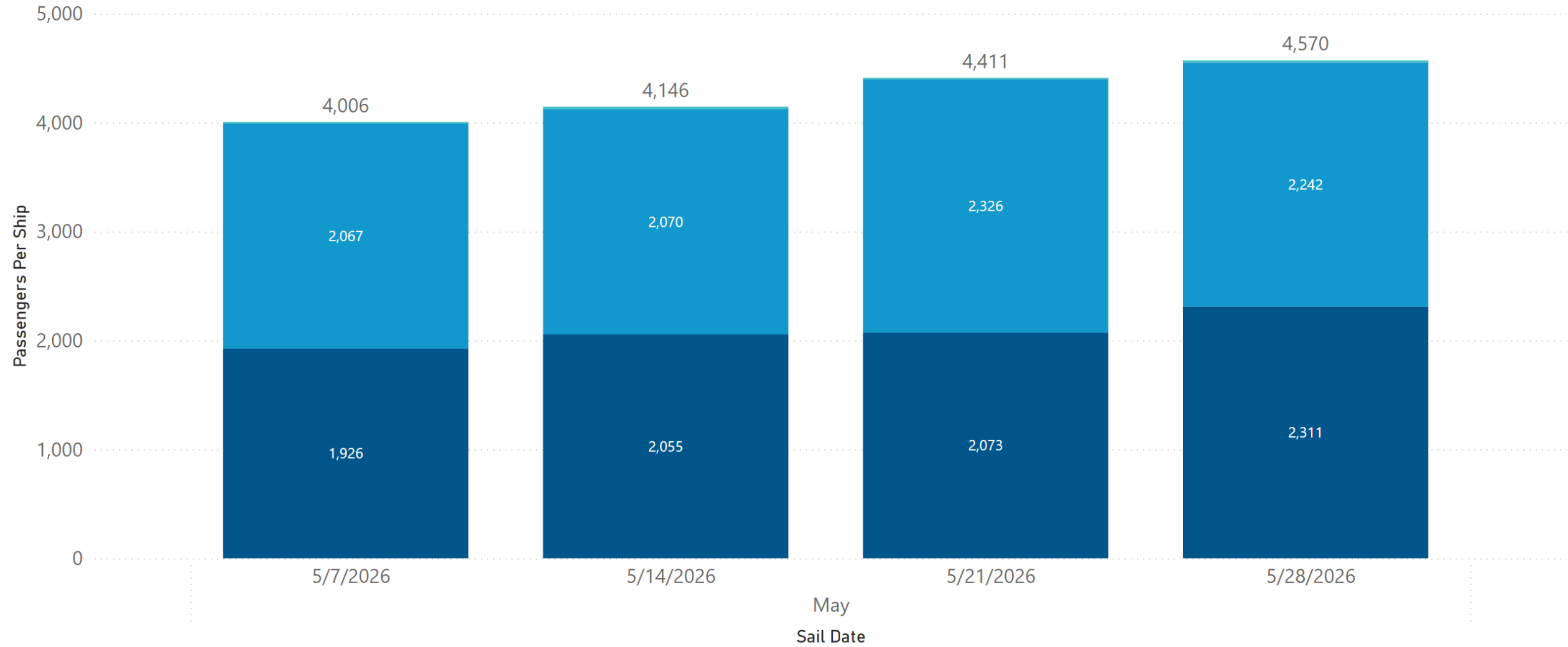

- Stricter eligibility and oversight, including, political review of awards, and increased scrutiny of applicants and partners
