

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Philadelphia Regional Port Authority (“Authority”) will conduct a public hearing on September 28, 2026 at 1:00 p.m. at its offices located at 3460 North Delaware Avenue, 2nd floor, large conference room and by teleconference for the purpose of providing a reasonable opportunity for interested persons to express their views both orally and in writing with respect to the proposed issuance by the Authority of a series of its bonds or notes (the “Obligations”) in the maximum principal amount not to exceed \$15,000,000. Proceeds of the Obligations will be used to finance: the construction of, and certain improvements to, a marine terminal located in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania (the “Project”).

Owner/Borrower: Philadelphia Regional Port Authority, a public authority and instrumentality of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

Maximum Principal Amount of Obligations: The aggregate principal amount of the Obligations is not to exceed \$15,000,000.

Location of Project: 4 Atlantic Avenue, Philadelphia, PA 19153, commonly known as the Hog Island Dock Terminal Facility, Tinicum Township, Delaware County, Pennsylvania.
